Dear Gregory,

After careful analysis and consideration of KIOF-LP's FY 2018 Radio Community Service Grant (CSG) application, we regret to inform you that the station's application was declined.

As stated in the application materials, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) determines station eligibility based on the information provided in the station's application. Qualified applicants are required to meet all requirements at the time of application.

KIOF-LP does not meet the criteria to qualify as a Level B station for the CPB CSG program at this time. Specifically, KIOF-LP is not eligible for a CSG because it does not meet the required Non-Federal Financial Support minimum of \$300,000, the two Full-Time Employee staffing requirement, nor the Audience Service Criteria.

You are welcome to reapply in a future application period once the station is able to meet the eligibility requirements for entry into the CSG program.
